YOUTH QUALITY CARE ASSURANCE

January 30th 6:30 Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) is a national multi-species quality assurance program for youth ages 8 to 21. It is designed as an annual education and certification program focused on food safety, animal well-being, and character awareness for youth producing and/or showing pigs, beef cattle, dairy cattle, sheep, goats, rabbits, and poultry.

Some livestock shows and programs have begun recommending or requiring annual YQCA certification in order to participate. This year, Washington county's YQCA training will be held Tuesday, January 30th at 6:30.
