"JEFF SETTLES MEMORIAL" WASHINGTON COUNTY CATTLEMEN ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION

Washington County Cattlemen Association Scholarships are available to high school seniors and current college students. Scholarship monies can be applied to tuition or books. One payment of \$1,000.00 for the full scholarship amount will be made to the recipient upon proof of enrollment. Scholarship money will be divided according to the need and number of chosen applications.

To be eligible, an applicant must:

- o Have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA (on a 4.0 scale).
- Be the child or dependent of a Washington County Cattlemen Association member. Parent or Guardian must have been a member during the previous year in 2023, a current member in 2024 and remain such while the scholarship is in force.
- Be a current high school senior and finish high school within the year they apply for the scholarship or be a student currently enrolled in a college/university or a vocational/technical institute.

Rules:

- Recipient must attend either a college/university or a vocational/technical institute.
- Recipient must enter the college/university or vocational/technical institute no later than the fall semester once the scholarship has been awarded.
- Applications must be postmarked no later than the last Friday of March (March 29th, 2024). Completed applications should be mailed to:
