Chicken and Dumpling Soup



Directions:

Chop vegetables into bite sized cubes; chop onion and garlic finely.

In a large soup pot, heat olive oil over medium-high heat and sauté the onion and garlic until tender.

Add the carrots, celery and potatoes and stir for a few minutes, being careful not to burn them.

Pour in the broth and bring to a boil. Add dumplings, a few at a time.

Turn down heat and simmer for about 15 minutes, stirring often, until the vegetables have softened.

 $\label{eq:Add-control} Add\ chicken\ and\ raise\ heat\ to\ medium-low\ for\ 10\ minutes.$ Add frozen\ peas\ during\ the\ last\ five\ minutes. Add\ salt\ and\ pepper\ to\ taste.

Ingredients:

2/3 cups cooked chicken, cubed
4 carrots
3 stalks of celery
3 medium potatoes
½ yellow onion
1 clove garlic
2 tablespoons olive oil
2 (32-ounce) boxes of low sodium chicken broth
2 cups frozen peas
1 (12-ounce) package frozen dumplings
Salt and pepper, optional
